There are always a few people who manage to read the fine print and figure out the ins and outs of winning more things, but I always wonder why so many people who are also eligible, do not bother.

There are lots of people riding Thoroughbreds and I emphasize the word "riding," because, to be eligible to win more stuff, you do not need to own the horse...you just need to be the one riding.

Each Thoroughbred/rider needs their own T.I.P. number...they do not follow the horse!

As a show manager, I have encountered lots of confused and misinformed people. My intention here is to inspire more riders to sign up for this FREE program, so that we can award more of the wonderful prizes the Jockey Club offers.

So, if you ride and show an

OTTB, even if you only go to a couple shows per year, do the following:

1. Visit: <https://tjctip.com/>
1. Check eligibility of all the Thoroughbred that you ride
2. Create an account
3. Apply for your individual horse/rider T.I.P. number for each horse
4. Bring your T.I.P. number with you and write it on your entry form at each show.

This is so easy, so don't miss out on winning more stuff doing the things that you are already doing. If you read this and forget before attending a show offering T.I.P. awards, go ahead and apply on your phone at the show. Remember, it's easy and free!
